



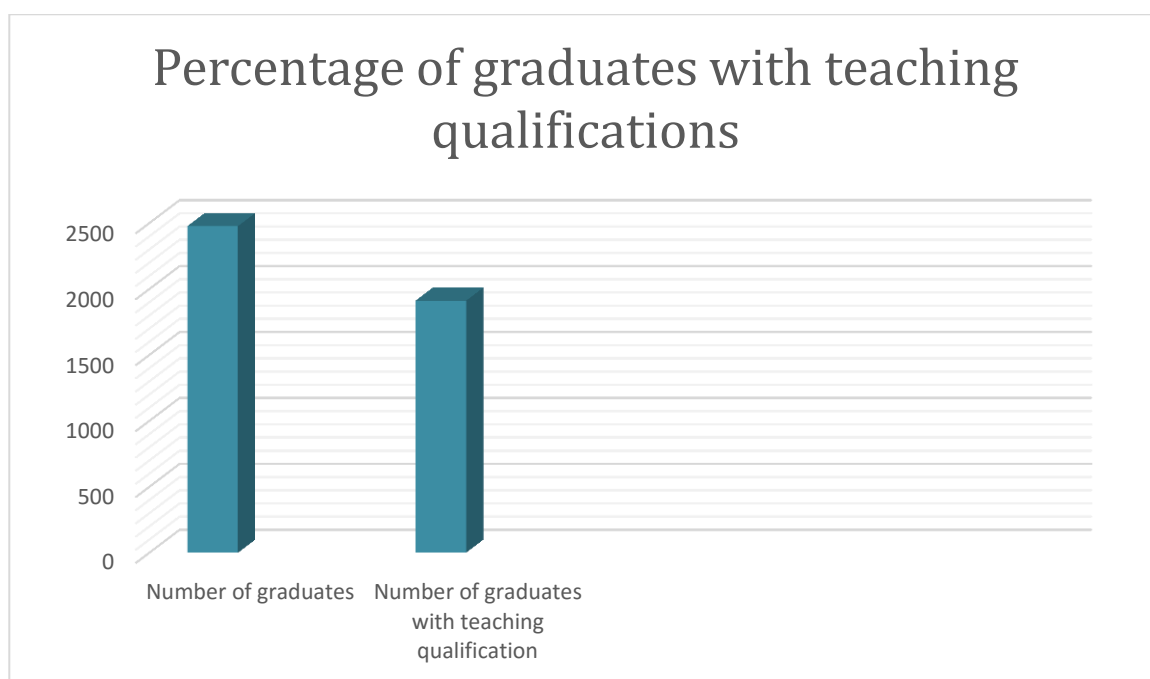

1. Proportion of graduates with relevant qualification for teaching

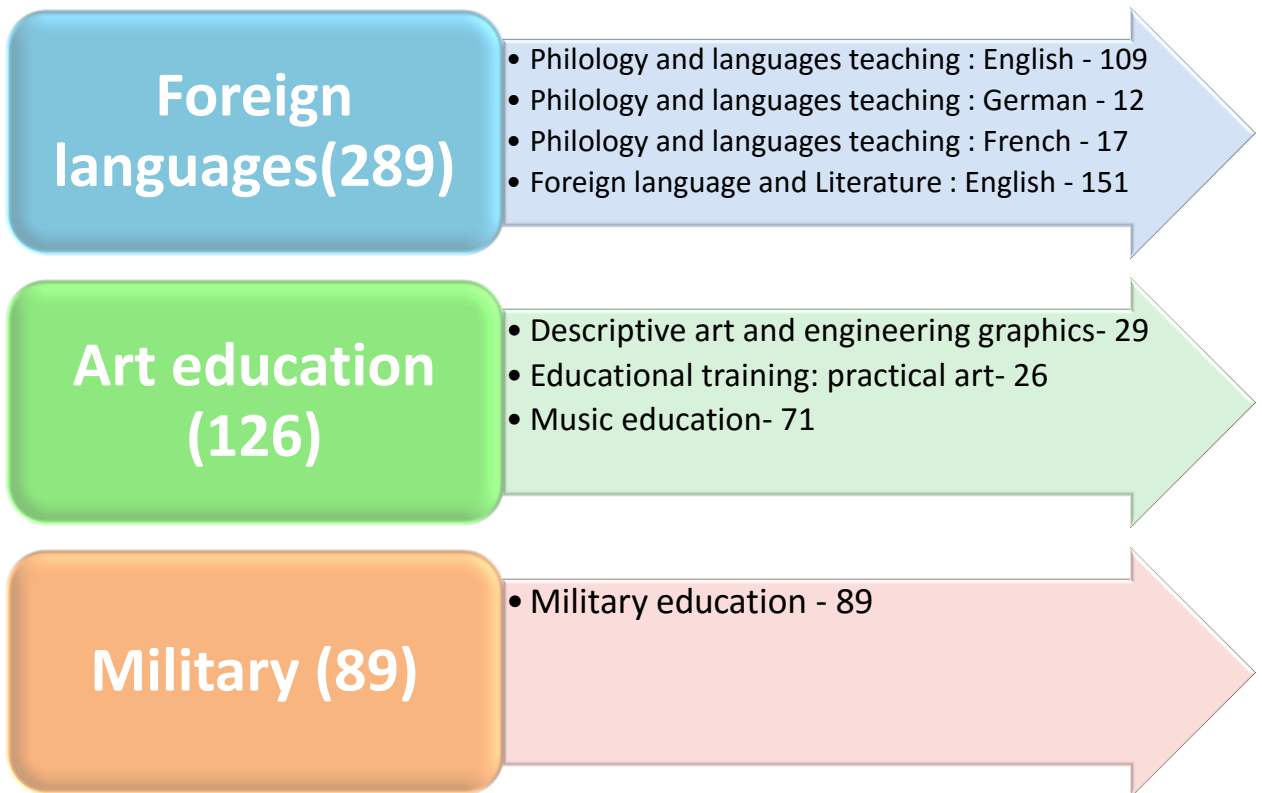
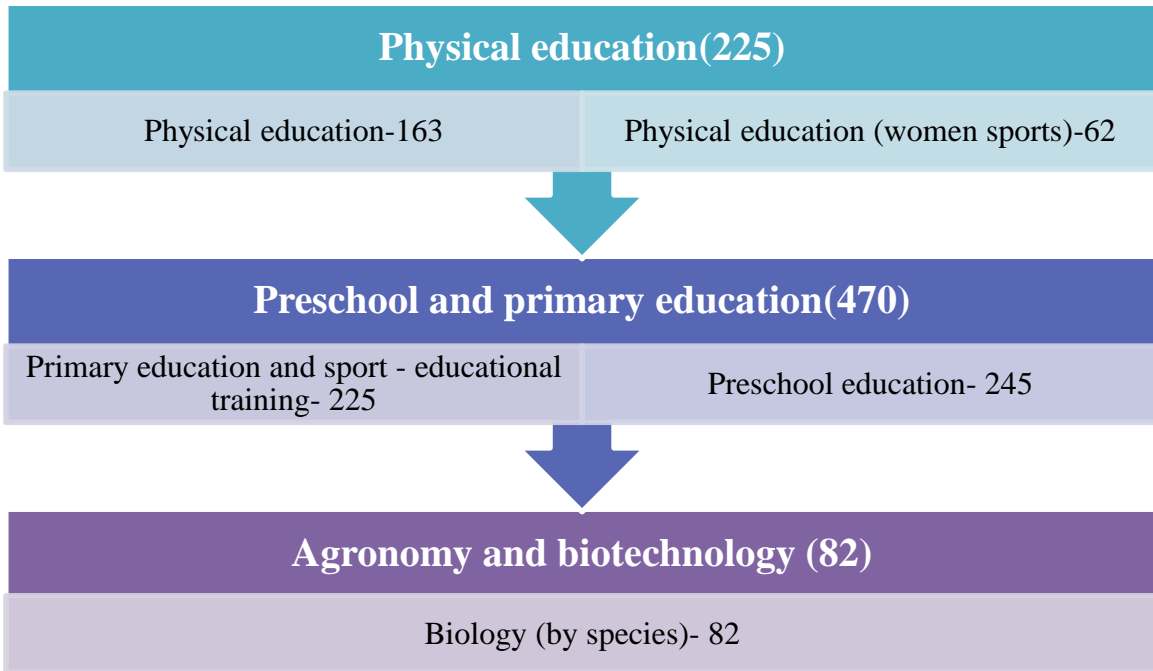
A total of 2,477 undergraduate students and 248 master students successfully graduated from Bukhara State University. A total of 1,911 of these students are qualified for teaching. In terms of percentage, 77% of graduates have the right to teach in schools. 100% of all masters at the stage of master's education have the right to teach at universities.

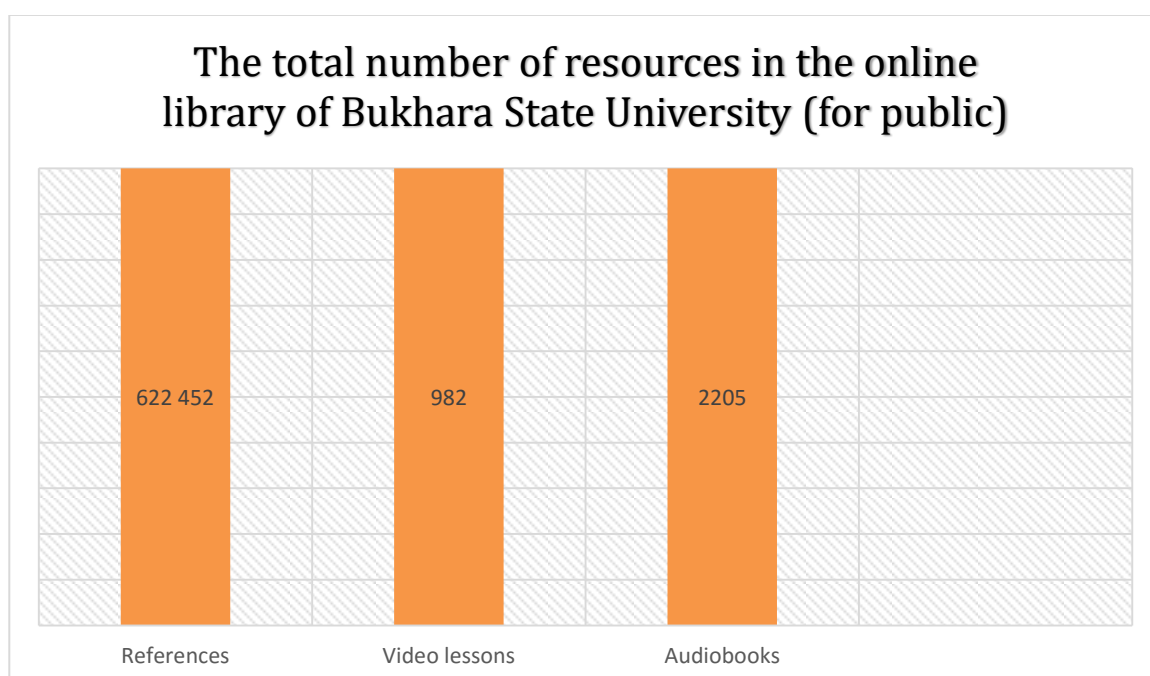

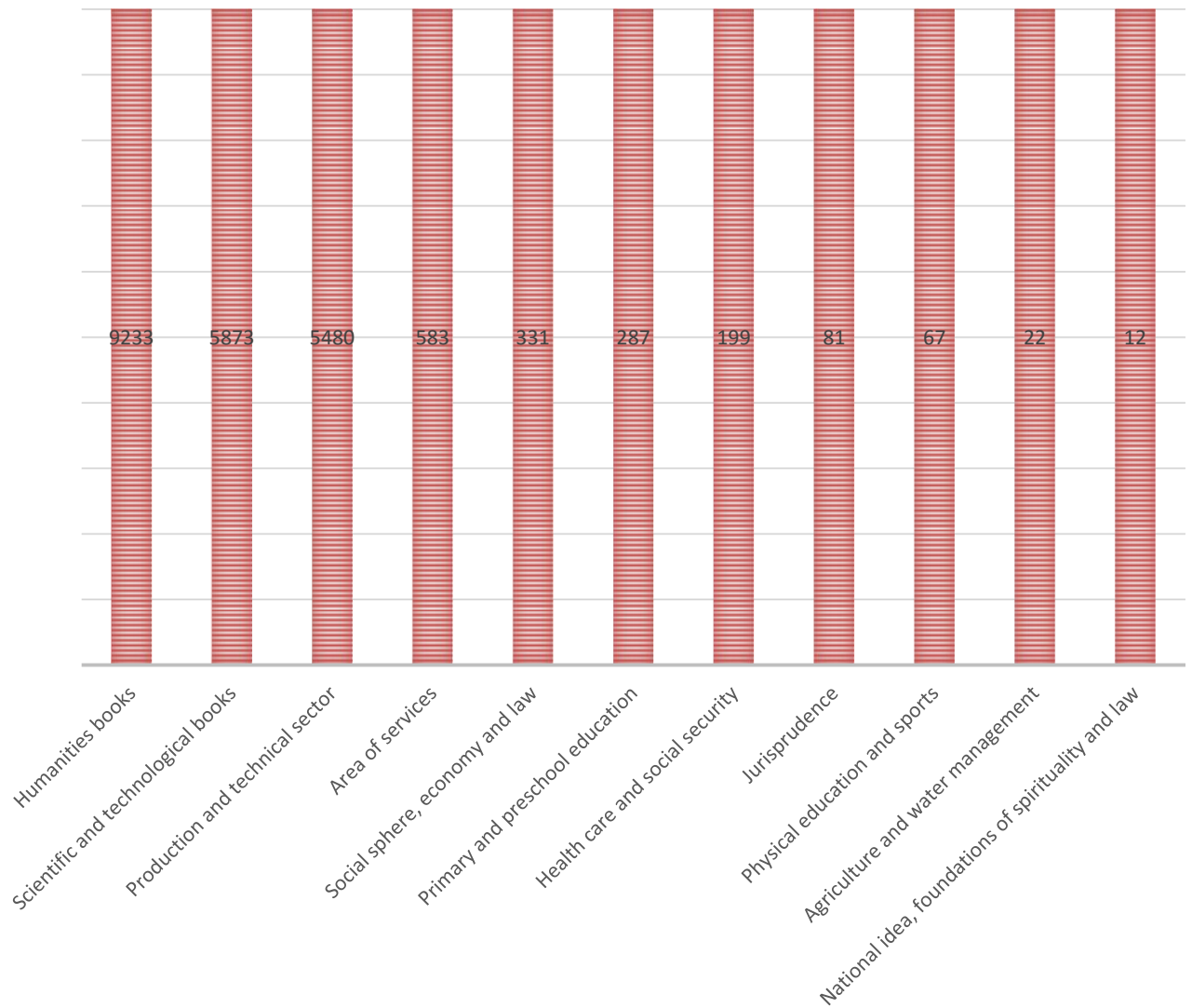


2. Public resources (lifelong learning)

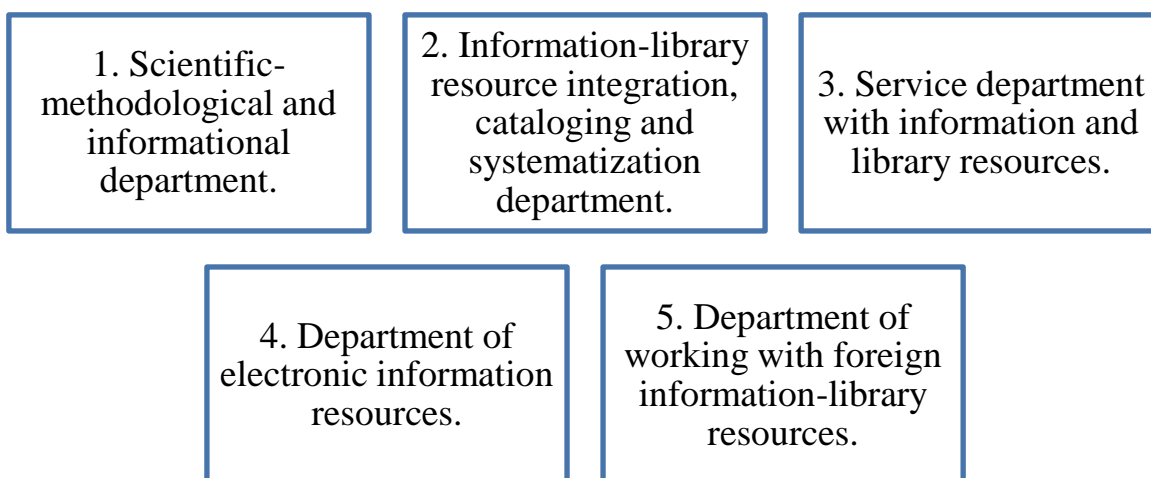

In addition, non-university students can use Information Resource Centers free of charge. The general fund of the Information Resource Center consists of 64,678 titles and 481,051 copies. Textbooks in 2155 titles, 45157 copies, educational manuals in 2904 titles, 119889 copies, fiction literature in 29733 titles, 138910 copies, scientific literature in 11515 titles in 68512 copies, electronic literature in 43064 titles, 47287 copies, other available literature in 18371 titles, 108583 copies.

In 2022, 838 copies of newspapers in 24 titles and 28 copies of magazines in 24 titles were subscribed. Rare books in the IRC, including rare and especially valuable publications, are stored in appropriate conditions. That is, they are kept in a separate room with normal light, temperature and humidity. There are a total of 25 eastern manuscripts, including 108 lithographs, in the IRC fund.

The university subscribes to international scientific databases such as EBSCO, SCOPUS, Web of Science, ProQuist, ScienceDirect. Professors, teachers, doctoral students, masters and non-university students who are engaged in scientific activities can use these databases.

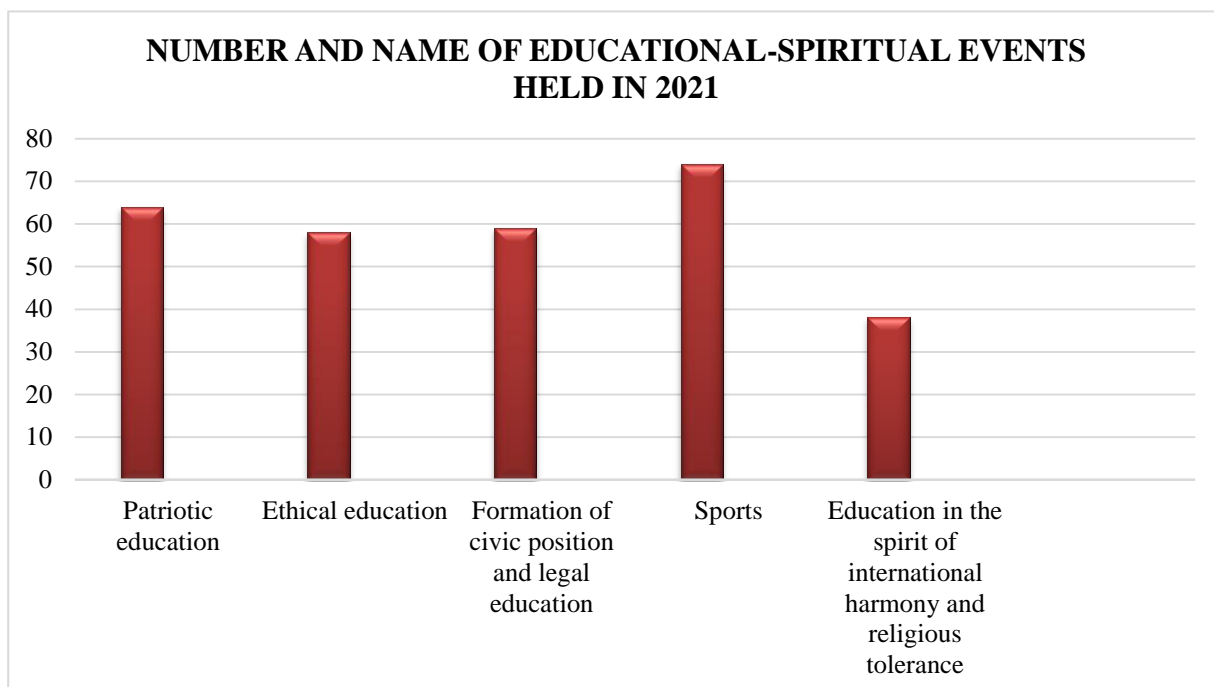

3. Public events (lifelong learning)

Bukhara State University constantly conducts educational and spiritual events. In addition, in order to ensure the implementation of seasonal measures, a "Monthly road map" was formed at the university. Based on the road map, the work to be carried out during the month is determined and its implementation is discussed at the end of the month. All regulatory documents justifying the activities implemented by the faculties based on the road map are summarized in the section. In addition, "Department Days" were organized in order to systematically implement spiritual and educational work in the student residence. Tasks performed by each department are defined according to the "Department Days" distribution plan. Within these tasks, special attention is paid to 5 initiatives. The activities carried out within the framework of "Monthly Road Map", "Department Days", "5 Initiative Days" (every Friday in the Student Residence) are widely covered on the official website of the university and on its social media channels.

In 2021, 64 on "**Patriotic education**" (with the participation of 170 professors and 5200 students), 58 on "**Ethical education**" (with the participation of 380 professors-teachers and 4800 students-young people), 59 on "**Formation of civic position and legal education**" (with the participation of 410 professor-teachers and 5870 students-young people), "**Sports**" 74 (with the participation of 2,300 students), 38 (with the participation of 140 professors-teachers and 2,580 students) meetings and roundtable discussions on "**Education in the spirit of international harmony and religious tolerance**", spiritual and educational events were held.



Patriotic education: July 2 is the 30th birthday of our coat of arms, which is considered a symbol of the state independence of the Republic of Uzbekistan. In this regard, early in the morning at the fountains named after Abu Ali ibn Sina, "The land that made the world charming!" Under the slogan, a holiday event was organized at the regional level.



Under the leadership of BukhSU Rector Obidjon Khamidov, vice-rector for youth issues A.Amonov deputy deans of the faculty, tutors and more than 200 students actively participated in the festive events.

"Ethical education": Pedagogical staff of Bukhara State University held a round discussion with students on the topic "FORMATION OF BEHAVIORAL CULTURE IN YOUTHS". In the round discussion, information was given about the unique expression of human manners, more precisely, human moral perfection, according to the



essence of the culture of behavior and content. In addition, the students are told that "Culture of manners" is a relationship based on the rules, program requirements, restrictions and prohibitions of universal morality in all spheres of personal behavior and life activity. Each student is different in behavior and manners. Morality is one of the forms of social consciousness, the essence of which is personal behavior, behavior, lifestyle, principles and rules of living. Morality is a unique method of spiritual and practical assimilation of a person, a necessary condition for the spiritual life of people.

"Career Day-2021" was held in cooperation with Bukhara State University, Bukhara Regional Labor Directorate, Bukhara City Administration and Bukhara Employment Support Center. An open dialogue was held for graduate students in order to ensure their employment.

More than 100 enterprises and organizations were involved in the fair, and about 3500 students participated. During the fair, more than 200 employment agreements were reached and about 50 cooperation relations were established.



International conference. According to Annex 1 of the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated March 2, 2021 No. 78-F "Plan of International Scientific and Scientific-Technical Events in 2021" "Comparative Literary Studies Hybrid Linguistics and Translation Studies" at Bukhara State University An international scientific-practical conference was held on the topic: problem, solution and prospects. This conference was opened by the rector of BukhSU, Obidjon Khamidov.

More than 250 leading foreign higher education institutions, professors, specialists, researchers and talented students of higher and secondary special education and research institutions of our republic participated in the international scientific and practical conference.



4. Vocational training events (lifelong learning)

A total of 50 short-term courses were organized in 2021 at Bukhara State University. Students and non-university students can participate in these courses. Basically, these short-term courses were conducted in physics, mathematics, technology, production, economy, service, tourism and hotel management, chemistry and biology, ecology, art and other areas. A total of 886 people participate in these training courses. These training courses are held both online and in classrooms. Some training courses are organized at production enterprises.

A Professional Development Workshop was launched at the Faculty of Foreign Languages of Bukhara State University in cooperation with ETA teachers Sarah Chatta, Zoe Randall and Ashley Lane, who are working under the Fulbright program of the US Embassy, and the Department of English Linguistics.

At this seminar, Boboqulov Abbas of the Faculty of Economics and Tourism presented his project "Creating a mobile application in the field of tourism". He received the guidance he needed to develop the project. Possibilities of putting into practice the online course of Baqoev Burkhan, a student of the Faculty of Physics and Mathematics, in the direction of information technology were discussed. In addition, Master's student Loic Fremont also participated in the seminar. He came to Uzbekistan to study the relationship between tourism and local development, to gain new knowledge in the field of tourism, to share experience and to contribute to the development of tourism in the Bukhara region.



5. Lifelong learning access policy

All people can participate in such events at Bukhara State University. Regardless of religion, ethnicity and disability. As of 2021, 277 students from Turkmenistan, 2 students from Tajikistan and one student from Russia studied at Bukhara State University. In addition, 245 students with disabilities studied at Bukhara State University and lived free of charge in student accommodation who needed on it.

"First Bukhara International Olympiad" in economic sciences was held at the initiative of the Faculty of Economics and Tourism of Bukhara State University. Foreign students took part in this international Olympiad along with Uzbek students.
