



Task for Teachers: Creating an Action Plan Using Practical AL Techniques

Objective:

- By the end of this activity teachers will be able to:
 - develop a practical action plan to integrate Assessment for Learning (AFL) techniques into their teaching practice
 - use specific strategies for implementing WAT & WLF, CUBAME, Exit Cards, and the Metaph and Missions Feedback Model

Instructions:

- Identify a Lesson Topic**
 - Choose a specific lesson where you will apply AFL techniques.
- Integrate WAT & WLF**
 - Define a clear learning objective (WAT).
 - Establish success criteria (WLF) to help students understand expectations.
- Measure Student Understanding with CUBAME**
 - Plan how to implement the "See-Think-Feel-Do" strategy in your lesson.
- Use Exit Cards for Assessment**
 - Design an exit card activity to check students' understanding at the end of the lesson.
- Provide Feedback Using the "Metaph and Missions" Model**
 - Plan how you will structure feedback to highlight strengths and areas for improvement.

- Create a short action plan (1-2 pages) outlining how you will implement these strategies in your classroom.
